The two additional Agency Commissioners 6 shall have terms of four (4) years, except that the first-7 individuals appointed shall initially scrve terms of two years. 8 Conflicts. 9 Section 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances of the Code of 10 Ordinances of the City of Tallahassee, Florida, in conflict with 11 the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the 12 extent of such conflict. 13 Section 4.
