

Frequently Asked Questions

What time does the Airport open?

Passenger terminal opens at 3:30 a.m.

Airline ticket counters open at:

- American Airlines 4:00 a.m.
- Delta Air Lines 4:00 a.m.
- Silver Airways 4:00 a.m. Monday–Friday; Saturday 8:15 a.m.; Sunday 2:45 p.m.

What airlines serve TLH Airport?

American Airlines, Delta Air Lines, and Silver Airways.

How long before my flight should I arrive at the Airport?

Air carriers recommend passengers arrive at least 2 hours prior to departure time and at the boarding gate at least 30 minutes prior to departure.
